Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! As we begin this new year of 2026, the Church invites us to see it as a fresh gift from God - a time of renewal and new opportunities to grow closer to Him. Like the Magi who followed the star with open hearts, we are called to ask: What is God asking of me this year? Perhaps a deeper prayer life, more frequent reception of the Sacraments, greater involvement in parish ministries, or simply beginning again with greater trust in His mercy. 
