My dear parishioners,

As announced this past weekend, Pope Leo XIV has accepted Bishop Douglas Crosby's resignation, and designated Bishop Joseph Dabrowski as tenth bishop of Hamilton. Bishop Dabrowski will officially begin his ministry in our Diocese on February 2nd (the feast of the Presentation - a feast that is important in our Diocese). In the meantime, Bishop Dabrowski has sent a letter to our Diocese which I

strongly encourage you to read! Printed copies will be available in the gathering space. My priest friends in the London Diocese speak well of our new bishop, one saying, "Charlottetown's loss is Hamilton's gain!"

This upcoming Tuesday is Remembrance Day, and lest we forget, we reflectively call to mind the heroic sacrifices of so many who lost so much, so that we may receive so much. Many persons faced violence, destruction, and death so that we might have peace, security and life. We owe it as a matter of justice to remember with gratitude and affection all those whose sacrifices have made the blessings we have received possible. In a world where many tend to focus on the negative, we need to take the time to call to mind how blessed we are. It is also more appropriate than ever on Remembrance Day to call to mind those who sacrificed for our country, and also to remember in November all the faithful departed.

On Sunday, November 16th, at 2 PM, all are welcome to join me as we visit Our Lady of the Angels Catholic cemetery to pray for all the faithful departed. We will plan to meet near the front entrance of the Mausoleum. Please dress for the weather! We will say some prayers together for all the departed, a most appropriate way to observe this month of November.

On Tuesday, November 18th, we will have our parish's annual memorial Mass at 7 PM, at which we particularly pray for all those we have lost in the last year (November 2024 to November 2025). Nevertheless, all are welcome as it gives our parish a beautiful way to support and pray with all those who particularly feel the pain of the loss of loved ones.

November is the month of the year where we especially remember and pray for the dead. What does the Church teach about prayers for the dead? Here is a selection of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1030-1032): "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence and Trent. The tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: 'Therefore [Judas Maccabeus] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin.' (2 Maccabees 12:46) From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead."

Our parish *book of remembrance* is also out again during this month of **November.** In the book, you can write the names of deceased family or friends. We will pray especially for everyone who is written there!

There will be upcoming gatherings here at our parish for altar servers, lectors and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion! It is essential that we sometimes review and improve the way these ministries operate. I am so grateful to all those who carry out these ministries! Altar servers will meet November 15th at 1 PM, Lectors November 22nd at 1 PM, and Extraordinary Ministers November 29th at 1 PM. We will review and clarify best practices, as well as answer any questions you might have!

Seminarian Peter has moved in and has begun staying with us! Please say hello to him and pray for him to be guided by the Holy Spirit as he spends time with us here at our beautiful parish!
