My dear parishioners,

Advent, a season of watchfulness and preparation for Christ's coming, begins this weekend. How do we prepare for the coming of Christ during Advent? The beginning of the new liturgical year is always a good chance to start something new in our life that will bring us closer to God. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you what God would like you to do for Advent, and listen with a generous heart! Here at our parish, there will also be a few changes during the season of Advent when it comes to our worship. For example, there is not usually a *gloria* during Advent, but we *will* have our Advent wreath with candles lit. You'll see a lot more purple during Advent! We will also change to another Mass setting (a Mass setting is a collection of music for Mass) we've previously used, which is the chant Mass setting contained in the Roman Missal. In addition, I'll *sing* the opening rites at the beginning, and use the "confess" option most of the time. Changes like this can help us enter more deeply into a new season, while at the same time helping us learn more about the Mass!

Congratulations to the newly Confirmed from our schools of Immaculate Heart of Mary (November 26th) and St. Gabriel (November 27th)! May the Holy Spirit continue to pour out upon them, that they may be faith-filled followers of the Lord Jesus, empowered by His Holy Spirit to brightly share His light to the ends of the world! "Come Holy Spirit, descend upon these young people, and fill them so that they may become strong and faithful followers of Jesus Christ. Amen!"

I strongly encourage you to please attend the *Colamici Concert* on Saturday, November 29th, 7 PM – it will be a short but sweet evening filled with beautiful music from many talented experts! Since this is a free event, I would really love to see the Church packed, and I strongly encourage you to invite friends and family and make a nice time together! All are welcome!


